
<u>Erasmus</u> Exchange Program

This Erasmus Exchange Programme is designed for students who would like to learn more about adventure education and community education. The programme is suitable for second and third year students of the field of youth, community, NGO, social work, education or leisure and sports studies. Students should already have some experience in hiking and camping in autumn weather.

The programme consist of the following fixed courses (20ECTS):

Leadership in adventure education 10 ECTS

 Theoretic approaches on leadership in adventure educaction, including independent field trip and conflict resolution project

Coaching-based approach 5 ECTS

 Coaching pedagogy in adventure education and community education, including a practical project in local school

Community educators as adventure education experts 5 ECTS

 Independent online course







In addition to the fixed courses student chooses 10 ECTS from the following optional courses

Entrepreneurship 5 ECTS

 Basics of entrepreneurship and learning to develop service products and business ideas

Network & partnership development 5 ECTS

 Joining the EOE conference (Marburg, Germany) with Humak Adventure Education students (students are responsible for all costs related to the participation)

Community education as a profession 5 ECTS

 Basics of community education, youth work, youth policy and the role of third sector organisations in society

Basic technical skills 5 ECTS

 Internship in the nature & outdoor programme companies in Lapland or in the Finnish Youth Centres

Finnish language 1 5ECTS

Finnish for beginners

English language and communication 5 ECTS

 Different factors of communication, professional terminology, formal and research communication, information retrieval and management





Prerequisites

Study programme includes an overnight independent field trip. Therefore the student should have basic level skills and knowledge about hiking and camping in autumn weather. A good command of English language, both spoken and written, is required since the studies are conducted in English. Student should also have good social skills and ability to work in diverse student groups.

Methods of instruction

Contact instruction/online, group projects, independent learning and supervised internship.

Evaluation

Evaluation is based on participation, written assignments and reports.

Other information

Students are responsible for their own personal sports and outdoor clothing and equipment such as rain gear, backpack, sleeping bag and mattress. Special adventure equipment such as tents and stoves, are provided during the studies by Humak.

Humak Nurmijärvi campus is located by lake Sääksjärvi, just an hour north of Helsinki. There are frequent bus connections to Helsinki. Housing is available on campus in double rooms with shared kitchen space (200€/month). Warm meals are offered at a student discount at campus.
